

NEW COVENANT CHRISTIAN SCHOOL CODE OF CONDUCT

Guarded by God's Peace

'The Lord is at hand; do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus." Phillippians 4:5b-7

As members of a Christian community, our behavior and conduct is to be guided by Jesus' command to love God above all and our neighbors as ourselves, everywhere and at all times: at school, at home, at church, and in the community. This applies to all members of the New Covenant Christian School community - administration, teachers, staff, volunteers, board members, parents and students.

As a member of the New Covenant Christian School community, I will, with God's help, endeavor to live a life of love towards God and others. This includes:

1. My Relationship with God (LOVE)

- Speak of God in respectful ways
- Encourage a close relationship with God in others as well as myself through activities such as Bible reading, prayer and worship

2. My Relationship with Those in Authority (HONOR)

- Be respectful in my speech and conduct
- Be obedient to those in authority over me
- Encourage others to be respectful of authority

3. My Relationship with Others (RESPECT)

- Be respectful of others.
- · Address others properly: refraining from name-calling, swearing or dirty language
- Encourage a culture of acceptance, recognizing that each person is created in God's image and likeness. I will encourage others, include others, and give of myself to others
- · Remember that there is "no touching except for helping"
- Seek God's forgiveness in a spirit of repentance when I fall short of the mark, apologize from my heart, and forgive others as God has forgiven me
- Respect the property of others and use it only with permission
- Use words to build others, not to tear down or embarrass

4. My Relationship with School Property (CARE)

- Be careful in my use of school property: the books, furniture, equipment, and the buildings
- Treat the playgrounds, playing fields, and all school grounds respectfully
- Report any damage done and pay for damages when I am responsible
- · Accept personal responsibility for the cleanliness of the school and the grounds
